

Upcycled By-Products

Upcycled ingredients allow us to reclaim and repurpose waste materials from agricultural, food, and juice industries.

Instead of being discarded, these ingredients are transformed into valuable by-products and raw ingredients, including seeds, leaves, peels, and stones, which can provide a nutrient-rich ingredient list for skincare and cosmetic products.

By-products contain key bioactive compounds that provide significant benefits for skin and hair.

Many by-products come from the processes of cold pressing oils and producing essential oils.

For example, many seed exfoliants and floral waters, which contain high-levels of essential fatty acids, antioxidants and vitamins, as well as key bioactive compounds that provide significant benefits for hair and skincare.

Any waste generated during these processes is repurposed, ensuring 100% raw material utilisation.

The versatility of cold pressed oils allows for endless possibilities, from lightweight serums to rich creams, hair masks and lip balms, tailored to specific skin and hair needs.



Exfoliants

They are made by crushing nuts and seeds to extract oils and then irradiating them to steralise them.

Many natural exfoliants are rich in antioxidants and other natural emollients.

This means that they can help to protect the skin from damage and keep it hydrated and moisturised.

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Waters

Hydrolats and hydrosols, also known as waters, are gaining popularity in cosmetic and haircare due to the increasing demand for products that are both effective and environmentally responsible.

Incorporating O&3's waters into formulations aligns with preferences for natural and sustainable ingredients as they are recycled from industry by-products.

All of the waters in our range that are 'hydrolats' are zero waste.

This means that they are the left over product and don't have any additional essentials added back in.

Steam distillation is used to create aromatic essentials.

During the distillation, the aromatic water left over contains minute amounts of the essential oil and is its own by-product.

Their very delicate aromas make them ideal for use in products for pets, babies, and people with sensitive skin.

They are also often used in anti-ageing products, as their delicate aroma does not irritate the skin.

Hydrosols and hydrolats can be used on their own as facial toners, mists, and hair sprays, but can also be added to other products, such as lotions, creams, and shampoos.

Many hydrosols and hydrolats contain soothing and anti-inflammatory ingredients.

This makes them ideal for use in products for conditions such as eczema, psoriasis, and rosacea, as well as to soothe sunburn and other skin irritations.

They are available from a wide range of plants, each with its own unique aroma, giving formulators a variety of options to choose from when creating products with a natural fragrance.
